

Stealth Starter System Guide

Which system is best for my bike?

SSC

In the SSC series (C stands for clutch drive) the starter motor engages clutch assembly similar to later stock systems.

Available for models 1937-54 (SSC-E, E for early) and 1955-57 (SSC-L, L for late)

SSK-R and SSK-S:

In the SSK series (K stands for Kickstart drive) the starter motor engages with the bike's original kick start system. Available for models with rigid frames (SSK-R, R for rigid) and 4-speed swingarm frames (SSK-S, S for swingarm)

^{* 1} works with stock plate but alignement precision of starter sprocket optimized and life span extended with heavy duty transmission plate.

^{*2} starter sprocket runs open and should be cleaned and greased once in a while.
